How do you become a Rotaractor?

A rotaractor is a member inducted under the oath of Rotary International. In order to be inducted one must

- maintain an 60% attendance rate
- have performed satisfactory under the PM lead project
- successfully completed an interview conducted by the Board of Directors

Privileges within the club

- hold voting rights
- can be elected as a member of the governing board
- would be awarded a membership pin
- must maintain a 75% attendance rate at Projects and statutory meetings and must not be absent for more than two consecutive statutory meetings. On your third consecutive absence, you will be deemed an inactive member. (For more information refer to the club's bylaws or a member)
- must pay annual dues (this an annually determined fee that covers fixed expenses, District Membership and Rotary International dues. (For more information refer to the club's bylaws or a member)

How do you become a Prospective Member?

On attending three consecutive statutory meetings, you are deemed a prospective member of the club.

Privileges within the club

- will be informed of and invited to all club projects, meeting and activities.
- may be subject to fines
- will be introduced to the club's closed social media groups where information on club activities are more readily shared. These group also act as social spaces for membership interaction and bonding
- will be made a member of a committee responsible for one of the five arms of service of the club. Active participation and input in activities of the committee is required
- will be required to actively participate in the planning of a project. This is likely through the development and execution of a club project lead by a group solely comprised of prospective members.

How do you become a guest?

To attend a club meeting or closed event you must be invited to attend by a 'Rotaractor'. Upon your attending your first meeting, you are considered a guest of the club.

Privileges within the club

- will be informed of and invited to club projects, meetings and activities. This may exclude closed club events such as club assembly.
- will not be subject any fines, these penalties will be incurred by your Sponsoring (Inviting) Rotaractor
